## HOUSECALLS SEASON 26 Episode Descriptions 2024-2025 Season

**EPISODE 2507** This week on HouseCalls, Ron shows how to save time and money on flooring projects. First, he demonstrates how to level and stain new wood strips to match an existing hardwood floor. Then Ron installs prefabricated oak flooring over a concrete slab to complete a new four-seasons room. Finally, Ron details the merits of durable and easy-to-install laminate flooring. First, he widens a dining room entryway in his own home to give the space an open, modern feel. Then Ron helps a couple assemble and install an attractive prefabricated storm door. Later, he adds decorative molding to a flat wooden door. That's this week on HouseCalls.

**EPISODE 2519** This week on HouseCalls, Ron transforms kitchen cabinets with adjustable pull- out shelving, increasing the amount of storage and making organizing much easier. Next, we welcome home improvement expert Brian Kelsey, as he demonstrates how to measure and install prefabricated window blinds. And while you may think a rotted piece of window sill means replacing the whole unit, Ron shows how to save money by repairing it yourself. That's this week on HouseCalls.

**EPISDOE 2520** This week on HouseCalls, Ron heads to Georgia to help construct a kitchen island by attaching stock cabinets and topping them with a countertop from the home improvement store. Then, Brian Kelsey returns to demonstrate how inexpensive edge banding can make plywood edges look professionally f inished. And Ron makes a playset area safe for toddlers by laying down a cushiony surface made of ground rubber. That's this week on HouseCalls.

**EPISODE 2521** This week on HouseCalls, Brian Kelsey guides you through the process of choosing, positioning, and installing a wall mount for a big-screen television. Then, Ron crafts a stylish slideout pantry for his kitchen, enhancing the space and making everything more accessible. And if you've ever been flustered by a stripped screw head, Brian shows a handy extractor that will quickly and easily pull it out. That's this week on HouseCalls.

**EPISOED 2522** This week on HouseCalls, Brian Kelsey explains the different grades and grits of sandpaper, and how to select the right one for your job. Then, Ron demonstrates how to remove and

replace a kitchen faucet...including a simple way to check for leaks. And Brian shows how easy-toapply veneer banding will give a stock piece of plywood a finished edge. That's this week on HouseCalls.

**EPISODE 2601** On the season premiere of HouseCalls, new host Brian Kelsey demonstrates how to replace an old thermostat with a smart one which can be controlled from anywhere with a cellphone. Then he shows how to install a rustic wall made of shiplap. Brian also patches small holes in a wall, making them disappear. **EPISODE 2603** This week on HouseCalls, Brian Kelsey demonstrates how to assemble, customize, and install decorative exterior shutters...an attractive upgrade to your home that's easier than you think. Then Ron Hazelton helps a collector build a mountable curio cabinet to display his prized mini-car collection. Later, Brian explains sandpaper grits, and how to choose the right one for your project. That's this week on HouseCalls.

**EPISODE 2604** This week on HouseCalls, Brian Kelsey shows how revitalize your home's exterior by getting rid of ugly chipped paint. Then he demonstrates how to thoroughly scrub a shower using a power drill. Ron Hazelton helps a couple build and install an adjustable desk and shelving unit that can adapt as their son grows. **EPISODE 2607** This week on HouseCalls, Brian Kelsey shows how to measure and install a retractable laundry shelf that's perfect for tight areas...it just pulls up when you need it. Then he replaces a damaged shower head, emphasizing that the fittings are secure enough to stop any leaks. Ron Hazelton builds a pull-out trash bin for his kitchen cabinet.
