2026-2027 Season

EPISODE 2707:

Imagine turning your garage into a true extension of your home. Brian Kelsey shows how a new epoxy floor can completely transform the space. Later, Brian shares a smart solution for keeping loose gravel walkways neat and in place using a special binding glue.

EPISODE 2710:

Ron Hazelton upgrades his kitchen with custom sliding drawers that make grabbing bulky pots and pans effortless. Then, Brian Kelsey installs a clever fold-out laundry shelf that saves space when it's not in use — and replaces an old showerhead with a secure, leak-free upgrade. Later, Ron shows how to anchor a child's heavy dresser with an anti-tip device for added safety.

EPISODE 2719:

Ron Hazelton breathes new life into a worn antique, transforming a vintage table from a rough consignment-shop find into a beautifully restored showpiece using simple refinishing techniques. Then Brian Kelsey tackles a common household headache—cracked, failing caulk—demonstrating how to remove the old material and lay down a clean, professional-looking new bead that keeps moisture out and surfaces looking sharp. Later, Ron teams up with a young DIYer to build custom wall shelving using MDF brackets and copper pipe—perfect for displaying caps, collectibles, and more.

EPISODE 2720:

Ron Hazelton heads to the mountains near Boulder, Colorado to help a homeowner transform a bare patch of land into a beautiful dry-stack stone wall planter. He demonstrates how to design, level, and construct a sturdy, mortar free wall, finishing with planting techniques suited to the region's climate. Then, Brian Kelsey

tackles a common but often overlooked space—the garage —showing how to turn it into a cleaner, polished extension of the home. Finally, Ron showcases a versatile tool designed to make removing flooring and trim faster and easier, offering homeowners practical solutions for both building up and tearing down.

EPISODE 2721:

Brian Kelsey demonstrates how to mount a large screen TV safely and securely, covering everything from choosing the right wall mount and locating studs to positioning, leveling, and locking the television into place. Along the way, he shares tips for determining the proper viewing height and making sure the installation is sturdy enough to support the weight of the TV. Then, Ron Hazelton installs a suspended drop ceiling in a basement, showing how it can conceal plumbing and wiring while still allowing easy access for repairs and maintenance. Later, Brian breaks down the different types and grits of sandpaper, explaining which options work best for stripping paint, prepping surfaces, and smoothing finishes between coats.

The episode wraps with a quick tutorial on replacing a worn door latch in a few simple steps.
